Monday 18th March: Nominations close at 3:30pm.

If nominations do not exceed the one parent vacancy, the new Council will be formed.

If nominations do exceed vacancies, the list of candidates and nominators will be displayed for voting:

Tuesday 19th March: Distribute ballot papers.

Friday 22nd March: Close of ballot at 3:30pm.

Monday 25th March: Count votes and declare the poll.

The newly formed School Council meets on the 26th March for the first School Council meeting at 4.00pm in the Staff Room.
