RE: Works notification

Dear Neighbour,

As you may be aware, Oberon South Primary School will relocate to their new home from term one next year – an architecturally-designed modular building on the current Oberon High School oval at Kidman Avenue, Belmont.

We are about to begin work on this exciting project and want to keep both school communities updated.

We can largely construct the modular building in a factory and piece it together at the new location towards the end of the year.

Construction timeline:

- Early work begins in late June. This will include connecting services to the new primary school site.
- July – November will be the most active period on site at the new site on Kidman Avenue. This includes earth works and the presence of construction vehicles. We will fence the site to keep it secure and safe.
- The existing primary school grounds will be subject to demolition in January 2021. We will fence the site to keep it secure and safe.

We will continue to update you as construction details are finalised. Our priority is to ensure the wellbeing and safety of all staff and students.

The new primary school will give students modern learning spaces and amenities, as well as new administration spaces and improved conditions for staff. We will also landscape the building surrounds and frontage on Kidman Avenue.

This move will provide the Belmont community with a new school in a prime location, that can be seen from the street and is close to the local kindergarten.

By January, Oberon High School will have permanently moved to its new location in Armstrong Creek. It too will gain modern buildings and better facilities, that equip the school to grow and meet the future needs of local families.

The current primary and high school sites will then be non-operational. We will provide further information regarding the future of these vacated grounds as this becomes available.
